The mechanic pleaded guilty to 55 charges relating to the issuing of 27 false or misleading vehicle inspection reports in 2023. Between March 1 and March 8, 2023, the issued false or misleading inspection reports on the vehicles. The offender failed to use the appropriate brake-testing equipment when conducting the vehicle safety and in the Magistrates words the actions were "criminal" rather than laziness. Brake tests are a vital part of the annual road safety check to keep people safe on NSW roads.


